INDUSTRY AT-A-GLANCE

Largest Apple Producer in the USA

Michigan is the second largest apple producing state in the USA* *USDA NASS, July 2023



14.9 MILLION APPLE TREES

There are more than 14.9 million apple trees in commercial production, covering 34,500 acres on 775 family-run farms in Michigan.

MILLION BUSHELS OF APPLES

The 2023 Michigan Apple crop is estimated to reach 32 million bushels (1.344 billion lbs.) The 2022 crop was a record 32,380,952 bushels of apples.*

Michigan Apples are available August through June each year, thanks to controlled atmosphere storage. 50%

About half of all Michigan apples are sold ready to eat (fresh). The remaining 50% are processed into other products.
